## C.S.I.A Ontario Hall of Fame



The C.S.I.A. Ontario Hall of Fame has been established in order that we may showcase previous and current award recipients.

## Hall of Fame Criteria

Nominations are reviewed by a selection committee comprised of two Hall of Fame members and a current Board member.

In order to preserve this award's high degree of honour and integrity, the selection committee's final decision must be unanimous. Similarly, the selection committee is not required to select an honouree nor is it limited in the number of honourees it may select in any particular year.

All nominations will be kept for a period of 4 years, and will be reviewed annually. Candidate submission forms must be sent in by the nominating person. Guidelines are as follows:

- a. Length of time actively teaching skiing. Ten years is the minimum.
- b. Length of time in the CSIA. Fifteen years is the minimum.
- c. The member should be over 40 years of age.
- d. Leadership and/or volunteer positions held within snow sports (i.e. Ski School Director or CSIA Board Member National or Regional)
- e. Contribution to our industry (i.e. what impact did individual have on our industry?).
- f. Has the member shown dedication to the sport of skiing or ski racing?
- g. Does the member show devotion to the CSIA and promotion of the organization?

## **Nomination Procedure**

1. Request for Hall of Fame Nominations must be sent by email on or before the 15th of February in each year.

- 2. All nomination forms must be returned to the CSIA Ontario office on or before the 1st of March in each year.
- 3. Only completed nomination forms will be considered. Please contact the Office Administrator at <a href="mailto:info@csiaontario.com">info@csiaontario.com</a> if you are having difficulty in completing a section of the form.
- 4. The deadline for receipt of nomination forms may be extended by the Hall of Fame committee, with approval from the Board, in exceptional circumstances only.
- 5. The Hall of Fame committee will make recommendations to the Board for the award.
- 6. The final decision as to the identity of the Hall of Fame recipient must not be disclosed to any person or organization until the information has been made public.
- 7. All members of the Hall of Fame committee shall execute a confidentiality form so as to preserve the integrity of the award.
- 8. Where a committee member is also the nominating member of a Hall of Fame candidate, he/she shall refrain from voting for the nominee.
- 9. Notification of an award will be the sole responsibility of the Chair of the Hall of Fame committee.
- 10. All members of the Hall of Fame Committee must commit to maintaining the integrity and the confidentiality of the process.
